ORDINANCE NO. 00-12-14-09

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LAGO VISTA, TEXAS AMENDING ORDINANCE 00-04-20-01 BY AMENDING SECTION 23 "PARKING OF AIRCRAFT AND VEHICLES"; ADDING SECTION 6.5 "EXTENSION OF FUTURE TAXIWAYS"; AMENDING SECTION 12 "FEES"; ADDING EXHIBIT A "DESIGNATION OF PARKING AREAS AND FUTURE TAXIWAY EXTENSIONS"; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAGO VISTA, TEXAS THAT:

Section 1. Section 23 of Ordinance 00-04-20-01 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 23. Parking of Aircraft and Vehicles. No part of any vehicle or aircraft shall be parked at any time within the hold line (100 feet of the centerline of the runway). No vehicle or aircraft shall be parked anywhere on Lot 57 (the airport environment) in such a manner as to inhibit the taxiing of an aircraft (parking means no qualified operator at the controls). Parking is allowed in designated areas. The following properties are designated as aircraft or vehicle parking: Lots 48, 49, 50 and 52 of Bar-K Airport Subdivision as shown on Exhibit "A" of this Ordinance; provided that no aircraft shall be parked so as to obstruct access to the aircraft fueling area and no aircraft may be parked in an existing taxiway easement.. The City Manager, or his/her designee, may allow parking in non-designated areas for special events at the airport. It shall be the responsibility of the pilot, upon leaving a parked aircraft, to properly chock the wheels and tie down the aircraft. All transient aircraft shall pay the fee for parking aircraft in accordance with the City's fee ordinance.

Section 2. Ordinance 00-04-20-01 is hereby amended by adding the following section:

6.5 Extension of Taxiways. The taxiway on the east side of the runway will be extended as shown on the attached "Exhibit A" to this ordinance. Persons building hangars within the C-4 Airport zoning category must extend the taxiways in accordance with City Council Resolution 97-796.

Section 3. Section 12 of Ordinance 00-04-20-01 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 12. Fees. Any fees assessed for use of the Airport, including but not limited to overnight parking fees or landing fees, shall be in accordance with the City's fee ordinance. All transient aircraft must pay for overnight parking of aircraft.

Section 4. Ordinance 00-04-20-01 is hereby amended by adding Exhibit "A" which shall be the same as Exhibit "A" of this ordinance.

Section 5. The foregoing recitals are hereby found to be true and correct and are hereby adopted by the City Council and made a part hereof for all purposes as findings of fact.

Section 6. Should any section or part of this ordinance be held unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid, or the application to any person or circumstance for any reasons thereof ineffective or inapplicable, such unconstitutionality, illegality, invalidity, or ineffectiveness of such section or part shall in no way affect,


impair or invalidate the remaining portion or portions thereof, but as to such remaining portion or portions, the same shall be and remain in full force and effect and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are declared to be severable.

Section 7. Any portion of ordinance in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict only.


Section 8. This ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage and publication in accordance with the provisions of the *Tex. Loc. Gov't. Code*.

Section 9. It is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this ordinance is passed was open to the public as required and that public notice of the time, place, and purpose of said meeting was given as required by the Open Meetings Act, *Chapt. 511, Tex. Gov't. Code*.

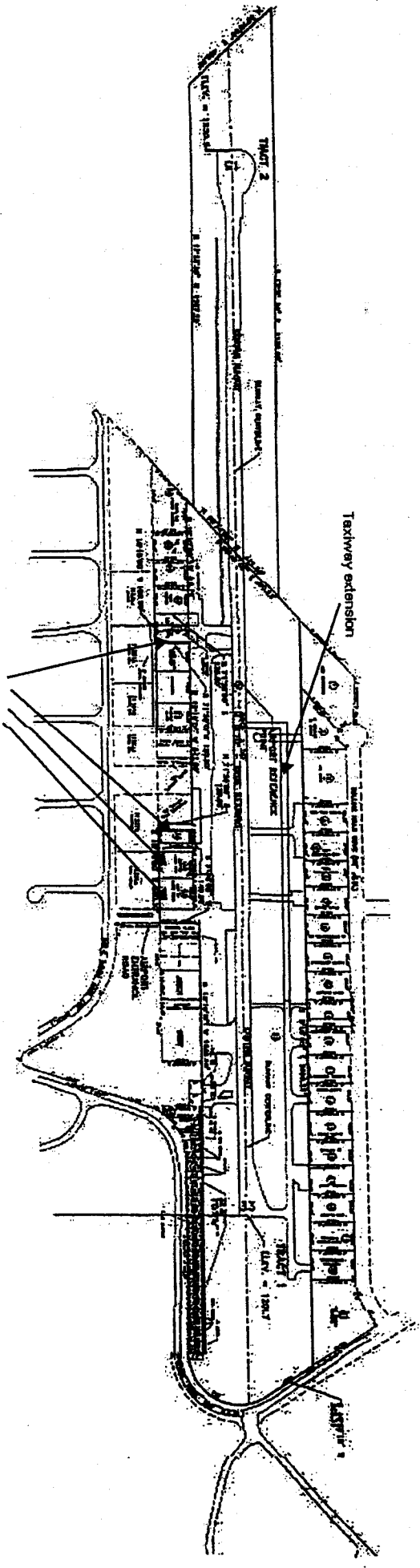
